

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE APPROVING AN AGREEMENT FOR THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF STATE RIGHT OF WAY; AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Commerce, Texas was held in Commerce, Texas at City Hall, on the 20th of March, 2018 at 6:00 p.m., a majority of council members being present and constituting a quorum, the following resolution was adopted”

WHEREAS, the Commerce Independent School District and Commerce – Community Action Program will be hosting a joint event on April 14, 2018 in downtown Commerce; and

WHEREAS, City Staff requests approval of the temporary closure of the following segments of State Right of Way for the 2018 Event as follows:

Business 224, through downtown, along Main Street from Park Street to Washington, ending at Caddo Street for the purpose of a Commerce ISD Bike Rodeo and Commerce – Community Action Program Resource Fair.

WHEREAS, the agreement is valid for 2018.

WHEREAS, the City Council believes temporary closure of the aforementioned streets is in the best interest of the citizens of Commerce.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVE BUY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The city Council of the City of Commerce, Texas, hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into an agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation for the temporary street closure for a segment of the State Highway system as more fully described above.

SECTION 2. That is any section, provision, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or word in this Resolution thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution, and the City Council of the City of Commerce, hereby declares it would have enacted such remaining portions, despite such invalidity.

SECTION 3. This resolution shall be in full force and effective immediately.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor of the City of Commerce, Texas, be authorized and he is hereby authorized to execute this Resolution; and that the City Manager be authorized to execute agreement and all instruments requisite in implementing this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Secretary be authorized and she is hereby authorized to attest to the signature of the Mayor to this resolution, and to attest to the signature of the City Manager to any instruments requisite to implementing this Resolution.
