

**RESOLUTION NO. 18 - 30**

**A RESOLUTION APPOINTING AN ASSOCIATE MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE TO SERVE PART TIME FOR THE CITY OF COMMERCE MUNICIPAL COURT FOR A TERM SPECIFIED HEREIN; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THIS RESOLUTION AND AUTHORIZING CITY SECRETARY TO AUTHENTICATE MAYOR'S SIGNATURE TO THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Commerce, Texas, was held in Commerce, Texas, at City Hall on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of October 2018, at 12:00 p.m.; a majority of Council Members being present and constituting a quorum, the following resolution was adopted;

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Commerce desires to appoint an Associate Municipal Judge to fill a vacancy in the Municipal Court of the City of Commerce; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has considered his/her qualifications and has determined that he/she holds the qualifications to serve as an Associate Municipal Court Judge for the City of Commerce, in a part-time capacity; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council has determined it appropriate to appoint Renee Booth to serve as part time Associate Judge for a period of two (2) years following the effective date of this Resolution.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that said appointment be confirmed and is hereby made and confirmed, and that said appointee take office upon taking oath of office as required by law.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Mayor of the City of Commerce, Texas be authorized and he is hereby authorized to affix his signature to this Resolution.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Secretary be authorized and she is hereby authorized to attest to the signature of the Mayor to this Resolution.

**SECTION 1.** The City Council finds and determines that Renee Booth shall be and is hereby appointed as the Associate Municipal Judge of the Municipal Court of the City of Commerce until his/her reappointment; or

until his/her successor is appointed and qualified. All persons serving as judge, regardless of term, serve at the discretion and pleasure of the City Council in accordance with the law.

**SECTION 2.** Should any word, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this Resolution be adjudged or deemed invalid, void or unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of said Resolution which shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 3.** All provisions of the Resolutions of the City of Commerce in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution be, and the same are hereby repealed, and all other provisions not in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 4.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.
